WHO am I?

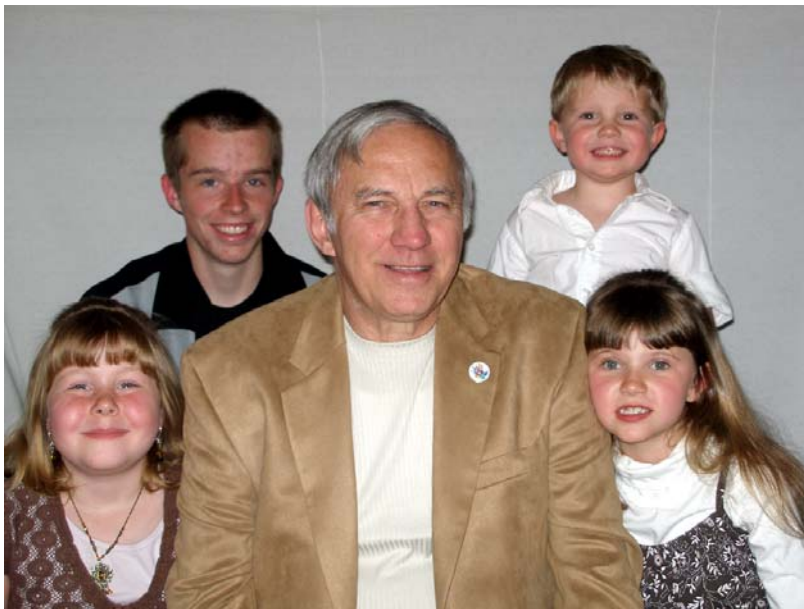

I served as **Executive Vice President of the Maine Jaycees**, organized and developed the first statewide multi-chapter **March of Dimes Walk-A-Thon**. I owned and operated **Duarte Typesetting Company** for 17 years, the first computerized book phototypesetting company in the State of Maine.

- I consider myself a true entrepreneur and small business visionary, having established our typesetting company in the basement of our Maine home with eight employees requiring new technology training where book composition was not part of the local commerce structure. Experience in this business environment exposed us to the U. S. Small Business Administration, banking credit lines, cost accounting, time studies, etc.

- As an industry specialist I taught the Introduction to Printing & Graphics at **Truckee Meadows Community College** for five years. Also my early years in Reno our typesetting company typeset most of the University of Nevada **Sports & Media Guides** 1987 through 1995. I also worked several years in the casino entertainment realm on stage work at **Harrah's** and as an audio video technician at the **Silver Legacy**.

- In retirement I established a non-profit 501 (c)(3) corporation, **US Nuclear Energy Foundation**, in late 2006 (www.usnuclearenergy.org), a grassroots volunteer directive to educate average citizens towards expanding clean nuclear energy development and waste repository management and storage.

- My interest is to bring my small business experience to the **Nevada Assembly** and work with the legislature to reduce government to a practical size for the citizens of Nevada. I also believe that we can develop a nuclear energy business in Nevada which could have the potential of reducing our energy costs and inspire a resurgence of industrial manufacturing.

Duarte's Mission in the Nevada Assembly

- The Nevada Legislature needs a blood transfusion. Gary J. Duarte, new blood for a new Nevada!

- Nevada's political circle has "talked" about commerce diversification for over 30 years. It is time we stop the talking and start the building.
- I am developing a method of email and/or social networking **DIRECTLY** with my constituents soliciting their **DIRECT** vote on legislative bills that I am voting on or proposing to the legislative body. By such polling and direct citizen response I am sure to be **REPRESENTING** my constituents which I believe is the **DUTY** of an elected official.
- Much of my work with the US Nuclear Energy Foundation reviews the footprint of a major nuclear power plant. I cannot **DRIVE HOME** enough, the **FACT** that "**energy IS the DRIVER of ALL economies worldwide!**" Nevada needs a major industrial candidate to stimulate a major direction towards commerce diversification. Two nuclear plants and reprocessing technology would be such a stimulus and could well change the entire future for Nevada.
- We must understand that economic development is **NOT** about **JOBS** . . . **JOBS** are the **RESULT** of economic development, industrial commerce expansion, small businesses **GROWING** to **BIG** businesses, and new businesses coming from startups, or from incentives from states with low taxes. This is simple common sense. Smartly run businesses will migrate to "smartly run states".
- Nevada's biggest "self-inflicted" problem of economic development has been its lack of industrial diversification, many would say the controlling focus of the casino industry. This has imploded upon itself. A single casino industry is unsustainable (*all your eggs in one basket*) is a basket case for failure. Nevada needs people who can see these issues and bring this message to the public.

ISSUES

DUARTE: believes government's "job" is to secure our rights as outlined by our Founders. Bigger government requires bigger taxes, waste and encroaches on our liberty.

DUARTE: opposes bailouts, stimulus packages and the auto industry takeover. Common sense would tell us if YOUR government can't run Social Security and the post office *and most everything else* why would we expect them to manage the auto industry? Just like the FEDs, Nevada government has shown us how they manage our economy . . . They overspent it!

DUARTE: supports increased domestic energy, nuclear energy production and opposes Cap & Trade energy tax schemes. Energy taxes do nothing but drive UP the cost of energy. Renewables, as much as we would like to dream would WORK, simply are NOT cost competitive or productive. They need to remain in the research labs and we need to "build" low cost carbon-free nuclear power stations.

DUARTE: stands for family values, truth, moral convictions and fiscal accountability. Many governmental services are provided to people who are not accountable for their own bad decisions. They cannot expect a bailout by taxpayers any

more than the banking system or any other corporation.

DUARTE: borders are established by countries for the purpose of protecting the sanctity of our land and its citizens. It is vital to the security of our country. Secure borders should be championed by our citizens. Naturalized citizens should line up to sign up illegal aliens and mentor them to naturalized citizens.

DUARTE: our Constitutional rights and the understanding of them should be the “rite of passage” for any citizen serving an elected governmental position in our country.

POSITION STATEMENT

I am NOT a politician. If elected I consider myself a **public servant**, honored with the privilege to serve the “people” and their interests for my district and how government can better serve them . . . committed to truth with integrity and moral conviction as a legislature.

ENDORSEMENTS: I am inundated with position questioners from unions, fire fighters, animal owners, etc. I assume that such organizations parse a candidate’s position based on questions of their directive and how a candidate would serve their agenda. It is my position that I field questions directly from citizens with such questions. Unions, political action committees and organizations as such serve to remove the public from direct contact with their public servant. I hope you can appreciate that I would like to reconnect my contact as a direct process with my constituents. For many years our citizens have been removed from direct participation with their Assembly representatives and it must be renewed.

We must deliver to our citizens that their participation in the government process as voters is a duty they share as citizens and we as legislative servants. I invite endorsements from any organization to study my published material and base your endorsement on the truth and integrity of my character.

TRANSFUSION: Our government needs a blood transfusion in its legislative body, a generation of dedicated public servants, not popularity seekers, not buildings named in their honor but political servants to rebuild the system of government, for the people, by the people and not for the politicians. Tea Party attendees are “Joe Citizens”. I will be pegged as a loose cannon but I believe the next elections are going to be won by candidates outside of the political box of elites, progressives, wealthy and connected. The public is going to “**go public**”, vote for the underdogs, sleeper candidates, long shots, poorly funded and **vote out** . . . “throw out” the re-elections, progressives, wealthy, elites of all parties!
